"I am sure you've noticed that we have a new Barbara Bus Logo(see above). I thought it would be of interest to explain the background and its significance to the Fund.

We decided that we wanted an image that was unique, instantly recognised but also relevant and encapsulated what the Fund was about. A number of excellent suggestions were made, but in the end we chose my wife Sue's idea of using the letters BBF in the shape of a bird. Birds were always important to my aunt Barbara, the founder. Her room at RNOH enabled her to feed and watch the birds and we often used to talk about how birds were a link to the outside world and were free to go wherever they wanted. As the basic principle of the Fund is to enable people, through the use of the vehicles and drivers, to be free to travel wherever they wish to go, just as a bird can, this image seemed very fitting.

Once we had agreed on the basic bird shape derived from the BBF letters, we were fortunate to have been introduced by David Thomas to Natalie Perkins from Realise Creative Limited. Natalie took the idea and turned it into the final professional and excellent version you see now.

So thanks to Sue for the idea and to Natalie for the hard work she put into giving us not only the completed logo, but also the ability to be able to use in various formats and applications. You will be seeing the logo on our letters, leaflets and more.

'Beth' and 'Charlotte' have both been with the Fund since 2004, and are about to be replaced – so hopefully in the early part of 2012 we will have a shiny new VW Caddy (similar to 'Sue') which will replace 'Beth', and then a few months later a very exciting development for the Fund – we have ordered a Volkswagen T5 Transporter which will be able to accommodate two wheelchairs travelling side by side, plus 4 seated passengers. We felt this was something that would add a further dimension to our fleet – it is not as big to drive as the Renault Masters, but does offer similar flexibility. If anyone is interested in buying one of the vehicles we are getting rid of, do please get in touch with us in the office.

Sorry to bring up the usual pointers, but it is important to make sure that everyone travels safely and considers other people. Please make sure that you know how to secure the wheelchair in whichever vehicle



you are using – and if you have any doubts do contact us in the office. Fuel is always on our minds, especially as it is so costly, and it is very time consuming for us to have to chase up people who do not refill the tank after using a vehicle. Please make a New Years Resolution always to return the vehicles with a full tank – when filling with diesel it is necessary to let it settle in the tank a little for a few moments before trying to fill more – this is the only way to get the tank truly full. It is surprising how much the vehicles use, even if you have only travelled a few miles, so please don't think 'the needle didn't move so I don't need to add fuel' if you do that it means that the next person to use the vehicle is paying for your trip! One last point – if you have a vehicle booked and realise that you will not be able to use it, do please let us know – just a simple phone message will do. The vehicles are very busy and we often have people on a waiting list, who may be able to use a vehicle at short notice.


